Our Mission





Sharing blankets across the U.S.



Our Blanket Angel volunteers live in Ohio and 37 other states. Most blankets made outside of central Ohio are donated in the area where they are made.

Our partnership with JustServe is bringing us a growing number of volunteers from other states through their justserve.org volunteer opportunity websites.

Hundreds of Blanket Angels, working alone or with a group, make blankets occasionally or just once. We also have 60 or so active Blanket Angels from 15 states who have made an on-going, multi-year commitment to provide blankets. We value every Blanket Angel and every blanket.

In 2021, our blankets reached

children in foster care in 33 states through our non-profit partners such as My Comfy Kits, Comfort Cases, My Stuff Bags, Stitched Together, Carrying Hope, El'lesun, Wendy's Wonderful Kids and Buckeye Ranch, as well as a growing number (300+) of public and private foster care agencies across the U.S.

Blanket Angels in these 38 states ordered fleece blanket kits and/or our special tags to attach to their handmade blankets that were donated to agencies in their areas in 2021.



Completed blankets were shipped to agencies supporting children in foster care in these 33 states in 2021.
